He spoke about his reasons for running, and his issues, including the ecology health care, reducing consumerism, the war in Iraq, and alternative energy. He will be an agent for change, not supporting the status quo like Courtney and his likely Republican opponent. The New London Greens voted unanimously to endorse Scott Deshefy for Congress.

We discussed the Presidential elections, and the Green debate in CA, and the Green primaries in CA and other states.
