

CTGP 2nd District Nominating Meeting
August 9, 2014/10:30am

The meeting was called to order at 10:45 by Ronna Stuller.

Doug Lary, candidate for Windham Registrar of Voters, spoke about his background and goals, and answered questions. Jean de Smet presided over the voting, and Doug's nomination was approved by consensus.

Scott Deshefy, the first Green candidate to run for Congress in the CT 2nd District, spoke about his lessons learned related to values and strategies.

Two candidates came forward seeking this year's 2nd CD nomination: William Clyde (Madison) and Amy Vas Nunes (Windham). Each candidate made a statement and answered questions. Jean de Smet conducted the voting, using paper ballots, with Barbara Barry assisting with the count. Results were Bill Clyde-13, Amy Vas Nunes-2, none of the above-0.

There were no candidates seeking endorsement for other races within the 2nd district.

Documentation was completed for submission to designated authorities, per Connecticut requirements.

Barbara Barry invited all candidates to participate in a teleconference with the GPCT Executive Committee on August 13 at 6:30pm.

Meeting was adjourned at 12:40pm.
